

In close collaboration with the HSE Department, we can plan and carry out the necessary courses for workers, both local and expatriate, to carry out their tasks at height, safely.



3. Installation of anchors and lifelines


Our team will select and install the anchors and lifelines required so that they can be used safely by workers.
